The school also received a judgement of “**Outstanding**” in Personal development, Behaviour and Welfare.

To be recognised as an exceptional establishment, with strengths in all areas is a great accomplishment. Furthermore receiving a “**Good**” overall for both departments confirms to us that our students and staff are passionate about what they do. Many areas were also judged to be working within elements of outstanding.
