SPRING TERM 1

Prophets were sent as a guide

Children will be:

- Understanding Why we have been created.
- What is man's purpose on earth?
- Exploring the fact that we are all the children of Prophet Adam a.s. What does this tell us?
- Discussing the story of Adam a.s.
- Discussing what has Allah provided us with to understand our purpose. Who did Allah send to guide us?
- Thinking about the role of the prophets.
- Who is the best of planners?
- What have we been to hold onto?
- Learning the names of the prophets mentioned in the Qur'an.

Personal Identity

Children will be:

- Discussing the meaning of identity.
- Exploring 'What makes you, you?'
- How do you define yourself?
- Learning about themselves.
- Learning about the children in their class.
- Discussing their likes/dislikes, strengths/weaknesses.
- Celebrating the similarities and differences between each other.

Who am I?

We are Muslims

Children will be:

- Discussing what makes us Muslims.
- What does it mean to follow the Quran and Sunnah?
- Exploring the qualities of a Muslim. Are these 'universal' qualities?
- Give examples of these qualities.
- Look at rights of a Muslim.
- Demonstrate ways of we can fulfil the rights of others.

Islam: Our Religion

Children will be:

- Discussing the meaning of the word 'Islam'.
- Reflect on 'Islam is a way of life.' What does this mean?
- Is Islam a 'global religion?'
- Discuss: Allah tells us: 'This day I have perfected your religion for you... (Surah Ma'adah:3).
- Explore the practicality of Islam as a religion.
- What is unique about our religion? It is a practical way of life. From the moment we wake up to the time we go to sleep we are always practicing our religion.
- Discuss etiquettes, duas, remembrance of Allah, salaah etc.

Gratitude

Children will be:

- Discussing the blessings of Allah upon us.
- Thinking about the countless blessings we take for granted.
- Thinking about Allah's love and mercy upon us.
- How can we show our appreciation to Allah?
- Many people through Allah's mercy do things for us. How can we show our appreciation towards them?
- Is it important to 'show thanks?' Why?
- Demonstrate ways to show appreciation.

Encouraging others to do good

Children will be:

- Discussing good deeds. What are good deeds?
- How do we know what is a good and what is not?
- Prompted to think about the example of the Prophet sallallahu alayhi wasallam and his companions r.a.
- Reflect on the following: Knowing that encouraging others entitles you to the same reward as theirs, as the Prophet, sallallahu alayhi wa sallam, said: "He who revives a deed from Islam gets the same reward as the one who performs it." (Muslim).
- Thinking of ways to practice on the above hadeeth.
- Understanding this is the way of our Prophet sallallahu alayhi wasallam- The Best Example.

Benefitting others

Children will be:

- Reflecting on 'The most beloved to Allah is the one who benefits others...'
- Pondering upon what it would mean to be the most beloved to Allah.
- Discussing who the people around who 'benefit' us are.
- What does the word 'benefit' mean?
- Thinking of the importance of helping others through examples.
- Discussing relationships with the people around us, how can we benefit the people around us?
- Demonstrating ways we can benefit others at school, home, everywhere...
- Understanding this is the way of our Prophet sallallahu alayhi wasallam- The Best Example.

Cleanliness

Children will be:

- Defining the meaning of 'cleanliness.'
- Pondering upon outer cleanliness and inner cleanliness. What does this mean?
- Are both important? Why?
- Discussing practical ways of outer cleanliness. What does Islam encourage us to do? Keep our bodies clean, clothes clean, surroundings clean etc.
- Discussing practical ways of inner cleanliness. What does Islam teach us? Think positive, think good about others, don't backbite, be sensitive to other people's feelings, be generous and kind, benefit others, co-operate, help others etc.
- Understanding this is the way of our Prophet sallallahu alayhi wasallam- The Best Example.

Co-operation

Children will be:

- Discussing the meaning of 'co-operation.' (sharing, team work, listening to others, taking turns).
- Looking at examples from the life of the Prophet sallallahu alayhi wasallam to understand the importance of 'co-operation.'
- Thinking about personal situations where working together was important.
- Seeing how even animals rely on co-operation to be successful.
- Understanding this is the way of our Prophet sallallahu alayhi wasallam- The Best Example.
