

Literacy

Poetry: Rhymes and Poems. To learn a poem off by heart. Children will be using role play to create innotation.

Fiction: Story Telling. Children will be learning about different stories from different cultures and will be creating their own stories based on their learning.

PE

Tag Rugby: Children will be learning about how to play Rugby and the rules that is associated with this sport.

Skills developed – handling, passing, tagging, attack, defend.

Science

Children will learn to recognise that light is needed in order to see things and that dark is the absence of light. They will also learn about how light is reflected from surfaces and use mirrors to carry out activities to support their learning.

Computing
