

Literacy

Poetry: Animal Poetry. To learn a poem off by heart. They will use role play to support their learning and increase children's confidence in speaking and listening.

Fiction: Traditional Stories. Children will read various types of traditional stories and create their own beginning, middle and end and put their story together for their Big Write.

PE

Swimming: Children will be taught about the safety of water and taught how to swim width and length of a swimming pool.

Skills developed – Balancing, agility, linking, coordination, observation, evaluation and co-operation.

Science

Children will be learning about vibrations. They will learn that sounds are made by something vibrating and that these vibrations travel through a medium to the ear so that we hear them. They will learn that sounds get fainter as the distance from the sound source increases.

Computing

Children will learn how to create their own animation. They will go through the process of creating their own storyboards and add effects, sound and speech within their animations.

Arabic

This term, the children will be learning all about du'as in Arabic. Towards the end of the term they will use their knowledge of Arabic to create a beautiful, illustrated storybook.

Islamic Studies

This term children will study the era of the Umayyads, exploring the lives of two great rulers, Mu'awiya and Umar bin Abdul Aziz. They will also recognize the reasons for the rapid spread of Islam during this time, the achievements and the good changes in the society and finally identifying the causes leading to the decline of their rule.

Art and DT

Based on their cross curricular learning children will link their Art and Design with Geography and create 3D sculptures of the Earth. They will go through the design process, making and evaluating their Art pieces and each other's.
