

Literacy

Poetry: Adapting Poetry. To adapt a poem in two ways: into a performance from memory, and into a news articles.

Fiction: Describing Feelings. Draw inferences which as inferring characters' feelings, thoughts and motives from their actions, and justify inferences with evidence. Discuss and evaluate how authors use language, including figurative language, considering the impact on the reader.

PE

Swimming: Children will be taught about the safety of water and taught how to swim width and length of a swimming pool.

Skills developed – Balancing, agility, linking, coordination, observation, evaluation and co-operation.

Science

Children will develop their knowledge of the Earth's (and other planets') place in the solar system, and their relationships with other bodies in space, in particular with the Sun.

Arabic

This term, the children will be presenting a short spoken passage expressing information about themselves and their hobbies and interests. As well as this, they will also be evaluating different forms of Arabic sentence structure.

Islamic Studies

This term children will study the era of the Abbasids, exploring the characteristics of an Islamic society and recognizing its achievements and contributions. Students will conclude this study identifying the causes leading to the decline and end of this great rule

Art and DT

Children to use a range of artistic methods to mix medias to create a skyline art piece. They will develop an insight into blending, mixing, selecting, using the colour wheel and moreover understand how light and dark shades come together.

Computing

Children will learn about computer networks including the internet; how they can provide multiple services, such as the World Wide Web; and the opportunities they offer for communication and collaboration.
