Next week is Marvellous Mathematician week at Land of Learning. The aim of the week is to give the children the opportunity to carry out practical maths activities to help them understand how and why maths is relevant to everyday life.

Children will develop key skills and mastery in mathematical thinking and have a wonderful time exploring the fun side of maths too! They will learn how Muslims have contributed to maths and maths in the Qur'an.

Marvellous Maths days will start with a special assembly for all key stages and workshops for Year 1 and Year 2. Children will go through investigations and tasks with different mathematical activities within their year group. A variety of mathematical logic puzzles will be displayed around school, encouraging children to think and reason. Children in Key stage 2 will take part in a Maths Snapathon in their classes and those who are successful will go head to head with other schools in the Interschool Maths Snapathon, which Land of Learning is hosting.
