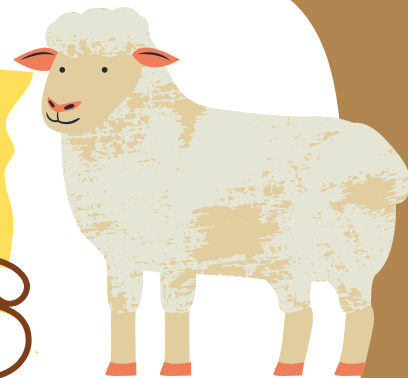

FARM ANIMALS



PSED

Children will be reading 'Wake up time on Bumble Farm' then they will discuss how the animals are feeling.

PD

Children will be cutting out pictures of farm animals, colour them in and stick them onto lollipop sticks.

LITERACY

Children will be reading 'My first search and find on the Farm' story by Alex Scheffler

EAD

Children will be cutting animals and stick them in their correct homes, such as a horse in its stable.

C&L

Lay a farm set up in the calm corner, ask children to sing Old McDonald had a farm and pick an animal, saying its name, sound it makes and to describe characteristics of it such as 4 legs and white etc

MATHS

'Subitising 5'

As milk comes from cows and children drink it regularly. Show an example by children to clap 5x & jumping 5x. Then encourage them to count 5 milk cartons backwards and forwards. Have a 5-frame ready and place them on there. Then swap by placing 5 cows on the frame. Can they quickly recognise 5 items without counting them?

UW

Show the children and farm animal PPT and discuss it with them. Allow them to become familiar with the names and habits of the animals.



FOREST & WOODLANDS



PSED

Set up a tray with mud, leaves, twigs, wood stumps, pictures of forest animals and pretend bugs. Let children explore in small groups, to see how they interact and make up imaginative stories with each other about the scene they have been given. Listen to their vocabulary and provide key words.

C&L

Children will be reading 'The Little Red Riding Hood' story book

UW

Children will be exploring Woodland's' role play set up in a tuff tray

PD

Children will be identifying the names of the animals that lives in the forest. Colour in the animal worksheet by staying within the lines.

Maths

Children will cut around the acorns and count the numbers written on top of each Acorn

Literacy

Children will be having a go at drawing different animals/nature they may see in the forest and trace the names for them

EAD

Children will be watching a video about how woodland animals behave in their habitat. Afterwards, children create an animal mask and act out a role of a woodland animal with their peers



ZOO ANIMALS

PSED

Mothers and their young matching activity:
Begin the discussion with the role of a mother.
Then relate to the baby animals and their mothers and discuss how they take care and look after their little ones and the feelings they have for their young ones. Put picture cards of mummy animals on the easel. Give each child a baby animal to match with the mother on the easel.

C&L

Children will be learning the names of different Zoo animals.

PD

Discuss different types of zoo animals with the children. Ask the children to act out the zoo animals.

Literacy

Children will be reading 'Dear Zoo' story book.

Maths

Children will be completing the Zoo animals counting work sheet. Let children name the animals and then count and write the number of animals in the box.

UW

Children will be exploring ZOO animals in a sensory box.

EAD

Children will be Make patterns that you can see on zoo animals such as, stripes for zebra, spots for leopard, blobs for a giraffe etc

Summer

C&L

PSED

Children will be sharing their favourite summer activity with the other children during circle time. Children will take turns to speak & listen to each other by passing around a soft toy around the circle.

Take some time to pay attention and really listen to the sounds of summer. Play a pretend sleeping game where the children lie down quietly and concentrate on the sounds they can hear around them. Ask the children what they could hear and encourage them to describe the sounds using longer sentences and a wider range of vocabulary. Which sounds are natural, quiet or loud sounds? Try playing the game in different areas to get different experiences.

PD

Ask the children to use their imagination to draw what they associate with Summer. Provide them with visual aid such as pictures of summer clothing, weather changes and animals. Let children create their own pictures and discuss with them that they have drawn and what it represents for them

Literacy

Discuss the importance of protecting from the sun during the hot summer days. Ask the children to cut out all the sun safety items and stick them inside the suitcase. Afterwards, ask them to name all the items in the suitcase and discuss how it will protect them.

Maths

Look at capacity. Pour water using a measuring jug and containers

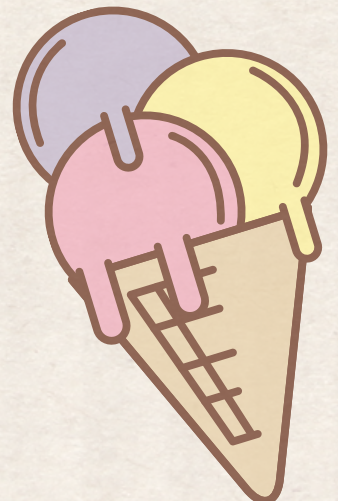
UW

Summer flowers.
Provide a tray of summer flowers along with magnifying glasses. Invite children to look closely at the flowers and draw pictures of what they can see.

EAD

Bubble Painting

Talk with children about the summer colours.
Use 5 summer paint colours.
Let children wear bubble wrap on their feet and let them walk freely on a long white paper



HAJJ

PSED

Children will be learning about the significance of Hajj in Islam.

C&L

Children will be reading various Hajj stories:

- Zahir & Jamal go for Hajj
- Tell me about Hajj



PD

Observational drawing of kaaba.

Literacy

Children will be creating a 'Hajj pass' and encourage children to write their names.

Maths

Children to select a number card and pick out the corresponding number of 'stones' to match.
Build 'pillars' using blocks and encourage children to talk about which 2d shape the pillar is similar to. Prompt children to discuss the names of the shapes with each other.

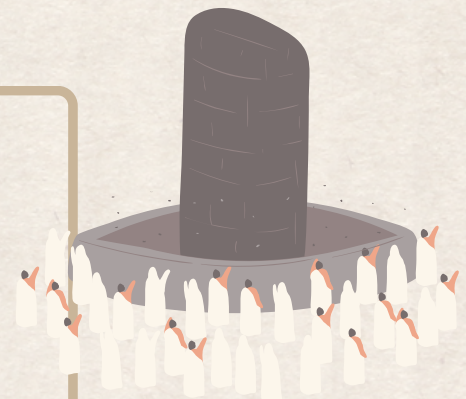
UW
